Wednesday	Bowl of water and towel (John 13:3-17)
Thursday	Bread & grapes or cup of wine (Mark 14:22-25)
Friday	Thorns (Matthew 27:27-29); Nails (Luke 23:32-33); Dice (Mark 15:24); Wooden cross (Mark 15:21-25)
Saturday	Large stone (Mark 15:46)
